PLI SCHEME FOR AUTOMOBILE AND AUTO COMPONENTS AND BATTERY STORAGE

458. SHRI SASIKANTH SENTHIL:

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of incentives disbursed under the PLI schemes for the automobile and auto- component sector and for Advanced Chemistry Cell battery storage, and the investment and employment generated thereunder;
- (b) the details of State-wise distribution of units set up under these schemes;
- (c) whether Tamil Nadu, which is among the largest automobile-manufacturing States, has received a commensurate share and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the details of steps taken to support ancillary and small industries in the automobile clusters, including in northern Tamil Nadu?

(a): Government approved the PLI Scheme for Automobile and Auto Component Industry in India (PLI-Auto) with a budgetary outlay of Rs.25,938 crore for enhancing India's manufacturing capabilities for Advanced Automotive Products (AAT) on 23/09/2021. The status of implementation of PLI-Auto scheme across all states are as below:-

Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme on "National Programme on Advanced Chemistry Cell (ACC) Battery Storage", approved in May 2021, with an outlay of ₹18,100 Crore for 50 GWh capacity. Till date, no beneficiary firm has claimed any incentive under the PLI ACC scheme. As reported by the beneficiary firms, the scheme has attracted an investment of ₹5,180 crore and direct employment of 1,277 till 31.05.2026.

(b) to (d): PLI Auto is a pan-India Scheme and approved applicants are free to set up units anywhere in the country. State-wise distribution (incl Tamil Nadu) of units set up under PLI Auto is as follows:
